

HEAD FOOTBALL COACH

The Head Coach is responsible for all aspects of the football program. The coach must demonstrate strong leadership in player and staff development, sportsmanship, integrity and character development. Qualified candidates should possess strong communication and organization skills. They must demonstrate exceptional knowledge of the skills and strategies of the sport of football as it pertains to interscholastic athletics in Michigan. Candidates must be committed to the Mission of Catholic education and follow the Essential Elements of an Edmund Rice Christian Brother Education while developing the mind, spirit and soul of every student-athlete.

Essential Responsibilities:

- -Foster among the participants and spectators an appreciation of the values of athletics, a desire to perform at the highest level, an attitude of good sportsmanship, and a sense of pride in self, team, school, and community.
- -Direct the training, conditioning, and performance of the football program. Lead and supervise the assistant coaches in their efforts with teams assigned to them.
- -Demonstrate current knowledge of strength and conditioning programs for football. Execute such programs during the off-season within the parameters of MHSAA regulations.
- -Emphasize the importance of academic excellence and assist in monitoring and maintaining high academic standards for members of the football program. Communicate effectively with the primary educators of the student-athlete.
- -Demonstrate the ability to build practice schedules into all positions. Portfolio that reflects offense, defense, and special team strategies.
- -Promote the football program and athletic department programs within the school and community. Prior demonstrated ability to provide positive leadership for coaches and athletes and to serve as a positive role model in all aspects of the coaching profession.
- -Works under the direction of the Director of Athletics and Principal in fulfilling their duties and responsibilities and expected to follow the guidelines listed in the Faculty Staff Handbook.
- -Demonstrate a strong knowledge and adherence to MHSAA regulations.



Qualifications/Experience:

- -Bachelor's degree required, Master degree preferred, valid Michigan teaching certificate preferred.
- -Minimum 5 years successful Varsity Head Coaching experience.
- -Completion of the Coaches Advancement Program (CAP) Level 1 and 2 for Athletic Coaches from the MHSAA, or agreement to complete these modules before the start of the second season of coaching.
- -Completion of CPR certification in compliance with MHSAA regulations.
