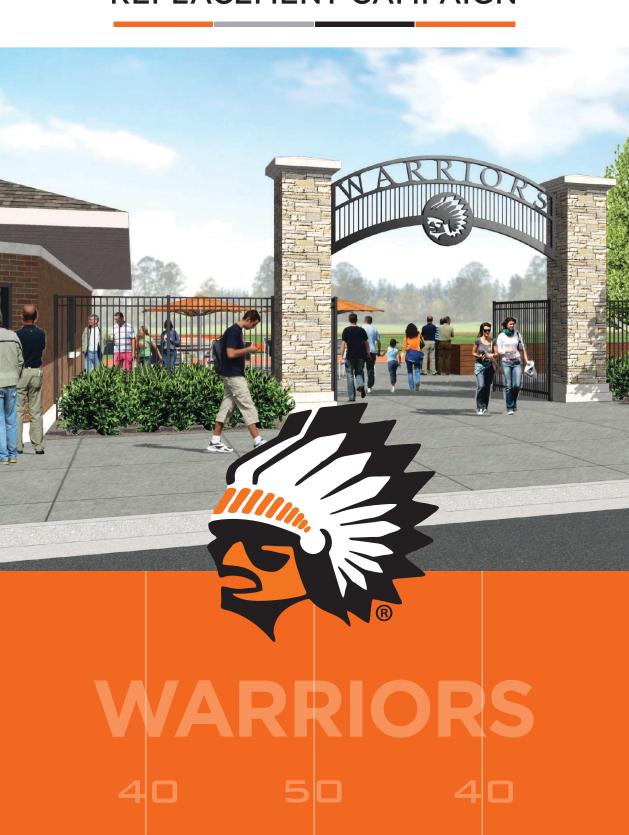


# Athletic Complex

# FIELDS AND TRACK REPLACEMENT CAMPAIGN





**Objective:** 

To replace repair, repave and completely rehabilitate the existing Brother Rice High School athletic fields and track, including the football turf, lacrosse/soccer turf, pole vault runway and high jump areas along with a new, technologically advanced, low maintenance track material.

#### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this capital improvement project is multi-faceted:

- To provide a top-tier athletic facility for our student-athletes.
- To reinforce the overall image, reputation and credibility of Brother Rice with students, parents, faculty, and the community-at-large. All students benefit from the fields and track. In addition, the community hosts several events throughout the year on these facilities.
- To increase the value, both perceived and actual, of the facility, educational

and enrichment experiences of Brother Rice. This is critical to remain competitive and uphold the values and standards of excellence for our school.

### Feasibility:

After receiving bids from various vendors, it has been determined that Brother RIce can perform all tasks necessary to complete the objective of replacing the athletic fields and track for \$1,500,000. The project can be enhanced to include a full renovation of the campus' outdoor athletic complex for \$3,250,000. A detailed proposal including product materials, descriptions and scope of work is available.

#### **Time Frame:**

The project, once funded, will be completed in two phases, beginning in the Spring of 2018. The fields and track will be replaced in the first phase, with the accompanying complex enhancements and renovations to occur in the Spring of 2019.
